



AVID Student of the Month

Criteria

First and foremost, students applying for this prestigious award must be in good academic standing. There should be no current failing grades and no negative behavioral remarks or referrals. Second, the student must fill out an application and return it to your elective teacher on the 11th of each month by the end of the school day. A student can fill out and submit an application each month of the school year until he or she has received the award. A student may only win the award once in an academic year. The winning student(s) will be notified by the 1st of the month in which he or she has been rewarded for his or her efforts in AVID and the community.

- 1. Students must have an unweighted GPA of 2.7 or higher and/or show significant improvement from the previous quarter.
- 2. Students must complete at least ten (10) volunteer/community service hours per quarter. If student is submitting an application in the middle of the quarter, their needs proof of the hours he/she has completed so far for that quarter. If student is submitting an application in the beginning of the quarter, proof of last quarter's service hours must be turned in with the application.
- 3. Students applying should be involved in at least one (1) after school activity. This activity can be within the school, a job, a community project, etc.
- 4. Students applying should have excellent attendance, with less than five (5) excused or unexcused absences for the current school year and less than five (5) unexcused tardies to school or to class for the current school year.
- 5. Students should get one teacher and one AVID peer recommendation. The teacher should attach an attendance report from the AVID teacher.
- 6. Students must have no behavioral issues or referrals; PBS points are a plus.
- 7. Students applying must be a positive role model, who follows school and classroom rules.
- 8. Students applying should write 1-3 paragraphs about their college and/ or career goals and how being a part of AVID has helped and will help to achieve those goals. This should also be turned in with the application.
